- Medium leaf size

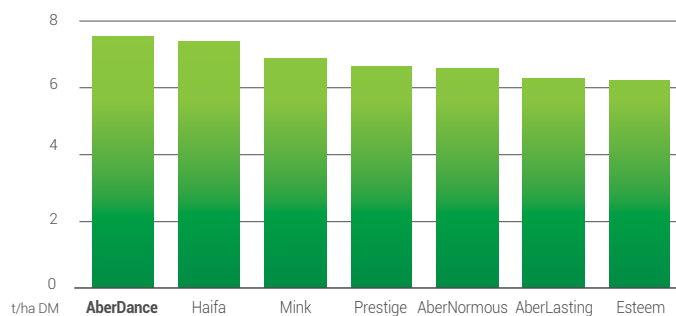
### Where can I grow it?

### Sowing

Sow at 3-5kg/ha alone or 1-3kg/ha when a component of a pasture mix.
